◀ WHAT'S BREWING HERE?

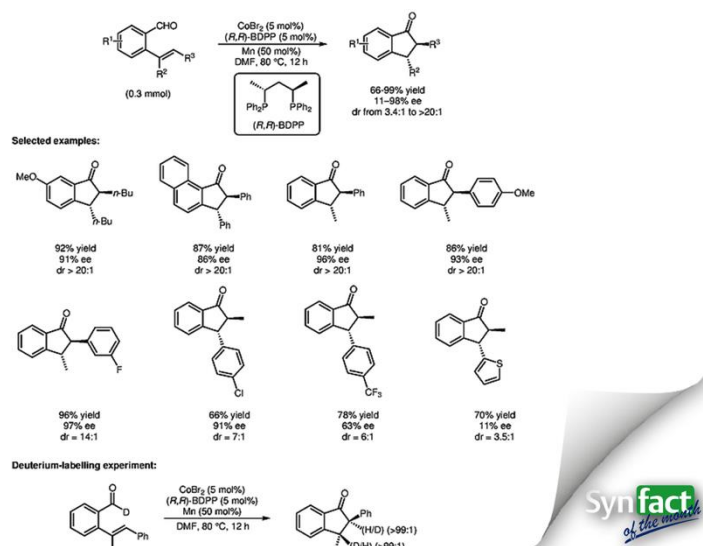


You have passed by this piece of architecture many times and might be wondering what this is for.
